TO: All Branches & Provincial Executive Council

Enclosed herewith please find brochures pertaining to the 2019/2020 Royal Canadian Legion Literary and Poster Contests.

The new combined brochure is intended to be distributed to all schools and displayed on school bulletin boards.

NOTE: Branches are to advise the School/Teacher that the following information must be provided with each entry;

Poster Contests: Every entry **MUST ONLY** have a **COMPLETED** entry form attached (no staples or other attachments).

Literary Contest: Every entry **MUST ONLY** have a **COMPLETED** entry form attached (no staples or other attachments).

Entries received without the above information are to be returned to the school concerned for completion.

Selected entries arriving at Provincial Command will not be accepted unless the Poster and Literary Remembrance Contest Registration Form #200832 is completed and attached to the submission.

Competitions will be governed by the regulations as stated in the enclosed brochure.

It is imperative that the deadline dates on the reverse be strictly adhered to, thus allowing for sufficient time for judging at all levels.

NATIONAL LITERARY AND POSTER CONTEST
Deadline Dates

1. Compositions and Posters are to be submitted to the local Branch of The Royal Canadian Legion no later than **November 15, 2019**.
2. Branches shall have the compositions and posters judged and submit the winners in each category to the Zone Commander no later than **November 29, 2019**.
3. Zone Commanders shall have the compositions and posters judged and submit the winners in each category to their District Commander no later than **January 3, 2020**.
4. District Commanders shall have the compositions and posters judged and submit the winners in each category to reach Command Office by **January 24, 2020**.
5. Late entries will not be accepted
6. The decision of the judges, at all levels, will be final.

In addition to the Dominion Command Awards, this Command will award \$50.00 to the winner of each of the categories at Provincial Command Level.

It is hoped that all concerned will bring this matter to the attention of the schools in their area so that as many students as possible may enter the competition.

Prompt action must be taken to supply the schools with the enclosed material to enable the students to have sufficient time to complete their compositions and posters.

Annual Poster and Literary Contests Judging Guidelines



POSTER CONTEST REGULATIONS

1. This contest is open to all Canadian students in the Canadian school system.
2. All entries are to be submitted to the local Legion branch.
3. Students who have been out of the educational system for more than two consecutive years are ineligible to compete in the Poster Contest at any level.
4. Entries will be no larger than 56 cm x 71 cm.
5. Please choose which contest you would like to enter and use only the following:

Colour: Full colour

Black & White: Pencil, charcoal and/or India ink

6. Entries will be judged on originality, expression of designated subject, drawing and illustration. **COMPUTER GENERATED ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**
7. The poster shall reflect **REMEMBRANCE** with a Canadian theme. If symbols are used, Canadian symbols shall be pre-eminent. Such national symbols are Canadian and provincial flags, coats of arms, and representative flowers, birds or animals, as well as all forms of Canadian historical and current military dress.
8. Candidates will complete an official Registration Form, available from the local Legion branch or online at www.Legion.ca. Attach it to the entry (no staples please).
9. Winning posters, at the national level, will be framed and placed on display at the Canadian War Museum in Ottawa for one year. Second and third place national level winners will be displayed at Parliament Hill during the week of Remembrance. All artwork will be returned to the artists through Provincial Commands.
10. A Contestant may enter both the Colour Contest and the Black and White Contest, but may submit only one entry for each category.

LITERARY CONTEST REGULATIONS

1. This contest is open to all Canadian students in the Canadian school system.
2. All entries are to be submitted to the local Legion branch.
3. Students who have been out of the educational system for more than two consecutive years are ineligible to compete in the Literary Contest at any level.
4. Entries may be submitted in either English or French.
5. Entries will be marked on the basis of originality of thought, expression, presentation, grammar, spelling and Canadian content.
6. Candidates will complete an official Registration Form, available from the local Legion branch or online at www.Legion.ca. Attach it to the entry.
7. Candidates will use only one side of the page.
8. Entries must not exceed the word or line limit as outlined on the entry form.
9. A Contestant may submit both an Essay and a Poem but may submit only one entry for each category.

ESSAY CONTEST SCORE SHEET

MAXIMUM POSSIBLE		SCORE
Original Thought 40%	Is the material fresh? Does it have a sincere ring? Does it reflect a student's view?	
Effectiveness of Presentation 30%	Is the material presented dramatically? Does it sustain interest? Does it make a point? Is it too long? No more than 800 words for Senior Essay, 500 words for Intermediate Essay or 350 words for Junior Essay.	
Clarity of Language 15%	Is the language simple, direct? Is it expressed logically?	
Composition 15%	Are the basic rules of syntax observed? Are the basic rules of punctuation followed? Is the spelling correct?	

NB: Judges at any level are not to change/alter any text on the submission.

POETRY CONTEST SCORE SHEET

MAXIMUM POSSIBLE		SCORE
Theme 40%	First consider the basic thought. Does it show original thinking? Is the theme presented in an exciting manner? Is the theme sustained throughout the poem? (within no more than 32 lines of poetry required for all categories)	
Effect 15%	Does the author succeed in maintaining any special effects? (i.e. staccato rhythm, explosive phrases or imagery)	
Clarity 15%	Is the message clear?	
Pace 15%	Is the pace consistent? Is it dull?	
Rhythm 15%	Is the rhythm of words appropriate? Is it natural? Is it exciting?

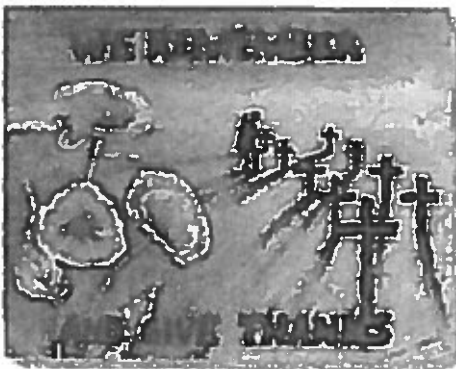
POSTER CONTEST

Colour or Black & White

Remembrance

Contestants are challenged to exercise their creativity and submit a poster on the theme of Remembrance in either colour or black and white.

This is a contest to select the most suitable posters submitted by students in the Canadian school system.



The posters will be judged at the local Branch and then at the Provincial level. The Provincial winners in the Primary, Junior, Intermediate and Senior categories will then be submitted to Ottawa for judging at the National level.

A plaque will be awarded to the 1st place winner in each category, and to the 1st place winners' schools.

Prizes will be awarded on the recommendation of the judges, whose decision will be final.

On notification of having been selected as a winner at the Dominion Command level, the artist or writer agrees to the full and exclusive non-profit use of the art or literary work by The Royal Canadian Legion for the period of one year, after which all rights for usage revert to the artist or writer.

Regulations

1. All entries to be submitted to the local Legion branch.
2. Entries will be no larger than 56 cm x 71 cm.
3. Please use only the following for the contest entered:
Colour poster: Full colour
Black and White: Pencil, charcoal and/or India Ink
4. Entries will be judged on originality, expression of designated subject drawing and illustration. **COMPUTER GENERATED ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**
5. The poster shall reflect **REMEMBRANCE** with a Canadian theme. If symbols are used, Canadian symbols such as Canadian and provincial flags, coats of arms, and representative flowers, birds or animals, as well as all forms of Canadian historical and current military dress shall be pre-eminent.

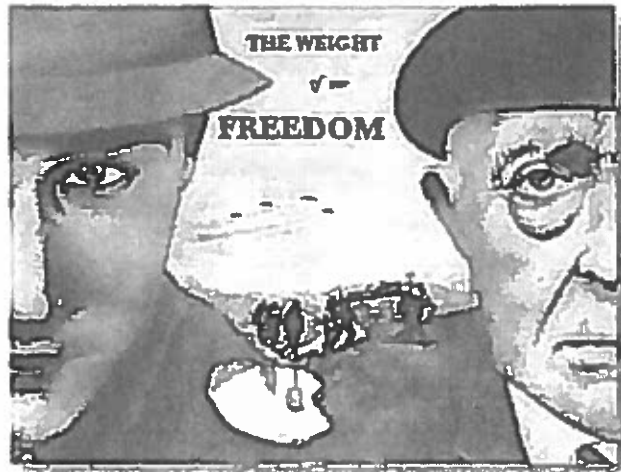
Essays and Poems

This is a contest to select the most suitable essays and poems submitted by students in the Canadian school system.

The essays and poems will be judged at the local Legion Branch and then at the Provincial level. The Provincial winners in the Junior, Intermediate and Senior categories will then be submitted to Ottawa for judging at the National level.



A plaque will be awarded to the 1st place winner in each category, and to the 1st place winners' schools.

Prizes will be awarded on the recommendation of the judges, whose decision will be final.

On notification of having been selected as a winner at the Dominion Command level, the writer agrees to the full and exclusive non-profit use of the literary work by The Royal Canadian Legion for the period of one year, after which all rights for usage revert to the writer.

Regulations

1. All entries to be submitted to the local Legion branch.
2. This contest is open to all students in the Canadian school system.
3. Entries may be submitted in either English or French.
4. Entries will be marked on the basis of originality of thought, expression, presentation, grammar, spelling and Canadian content.
5. Candidates must complete an official Registration Form, available from the local Legion branch or on line at legion.ca/contests, and attach it to their entry (no staples please).

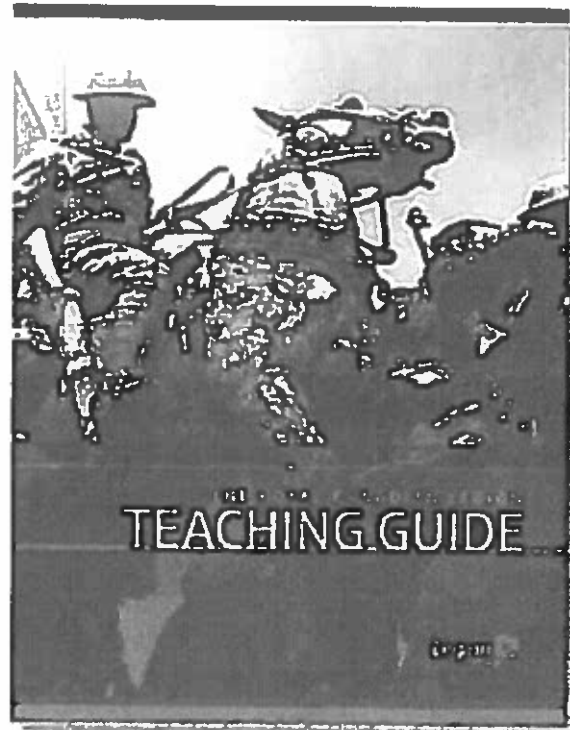
